Case Management

Available for children by a Qualified Mental support in the home, school, or community to promote personal achievement, and social

Psychosocial Groups

Helps to build social. emotional, and life skills through goals, teamwork, creativity.

Attendant Care

Parent Support

Helps families engage in their child's mental health care, teach effective parenting skills, connect them to resources, and offer educational support

Independent Living

Supports youth preparing for adulthood by building skills for success in employment, housing, education, and community life.

Respite

Provides relief to children and their families in order to maintain a stable lifestyle. Services are contracted with DCCCA. Inc.
